MEN'S BASKETBALL LEAGUE

UNRATED

OBJECTIVE:

To uphold the value of sportsmanship and enhance respect between and among players, strengthen camaraderie and forge mutual cooperation among fellow Filipino basketball players.

Keep on active, fit and healthy lifestyle both physically and mentally despite the hectic routine at work here in the U.A.E.

CLASSIFICATION OF PLAYERS:

- Player/s must be physically fit.
- Age requirement is from 18 years old above.
- No height limit.
- **ONLY UNRATED** players are allowed to play
- Player/s and coaches are required to sign a waiver to be given by TAG 91.1, failure to sign a waiver player/s and coaches is prohibited to play.
- Official lineup and waiver must be submitted before a team can play.
- Maximum of 12 players.



TEAM COMPOSITION:

Each team may have a maximum of twelve (12) players on the line up and allowed to play in a particular scheduled game. Changing of player/s after submission of final lineup is prohibited. The player/s who did not play a single game during elimination round is prohibited to play to the next round.

During the game, each team must always wear their complete uniform, and if the team doesn't have and other team wears their complete uniform they will get 5 points and will be added to the final score.

All teams should have their complete uniform after their 4th game, if still not completed after elimination; the team will not be allowed to play. All uniforms must have their own surnames. No alias and no blank names. The jersey must be properly tucked in on the short.

BENCH DECORUM/CONDUCT

- Team followers must observe proper bench decorum during the course of the game. Wearing of slippers of all bench personnel is prohibited.
- Only the head coach is allowed to stand during the game, the assistant coach (if present) can stand only to give instruction to the players.
- During an altercation inside the court, only the coach is allowed to enter just to pacify his player/s. Team followers are not allowed to enter the court and leave their respective benches to join the altercation.
- In case of the injured player/s during the game, the coach, team doctor (if present) and team follower is allowed to enter the court with the permission of the game officials.



PERIOD AND FORFEITURE OF GAME

- Game will be ten (10) minutes per period as FIBA rules. A grace period of fifteen (15) minutes will be given to each team before forfeiture of game.

FIBA RULES WILL BE APPLIED

WALK OUT

A walk out is a team refusal to continue playing a game manifested by among others.

The whole team leaves the playing court and refuses to continue to play the game. Each team does not physically walk out from the court but refuses to field in the five (5) players required to continue the game.

Substantially all the members of the team leaves the court and only a few remains, such that the teams cannot put a legitimate challenge against the opposing team.

PROTEST PROCEDURE

Any protest has to be filled with in twenty four (24) hours after the game, otherwise it will not be accepted. The captain shall immediately sign the score sheet for filling a protest.

OTHER MATTERS

TAG 91.1 has the authority to cancel or postponed the game/s, if there are unexpected situations such as electrical failure, weather condition, malfunction of equipment or unresolved team squabble.



- Resumption of games will be announced and only the players present in the postponed game will be allowed to play. The time remaining in that particular game will resume.
- TAG 91.1 appoints Janzen Kate Sport Tournaments Organizing Services to provide their in-house referees to officiate during Paliga Sa TAG-Araw 2018.
- The Commissioner has the right and power to make any decisions no covered by this rule, but subject to deliberation with TAG 91.1.
- In case of a buzzer-beater scenario, a video aid reply will be considered for review, if any.
- In case where a game clock display shows less than 0.5 of a second, it shall not be playable anymore and the game ends. However, if it shows 0.5 second or above, the game clock will be reset to one (1) second.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

The proper conduct of the game demands the full and loyal cooperation of the members of both competing team with the officials, table officials, THE COMMISSIONER and the TECHNICAL COMMITTEE.

Each TEAM shall do its best to secure victory but this must be done in the spirit of sportsmanship and fair play.



COMMITTEE ON DISCIPLINE

TAG 91.1 & the Organizing Committee upholds the safeguard and the spirit of the league and the rules and regulations promulgated by the committee. It reserves the right to disqualify and/or suspend player/s or coach for the violation of the rules and regulations, unsportsmanlike behavior and the use of excess roughness during the contested game.
